Coaching/cox	Category for those actively involved in coxing/coaching and assisting. May not row in club boats nor store private boats. To qualify for this category you must be currently active at Newport Rowing Club and is at the discretion of the committee. Those who wish to row as well need to take out full membership.	£60
Supporter	Category for those not actively involved in rowing but still want to be members. May not row in club boats nor store private boats.	£20
Junior	A full member but in full time education and under 18. Cannot be an officer	£140
Off Island resident	Category for those not resident on the Isle of Wight and not actively involved in the Club, but who still want to retain their membership and race for, or row from the club occasionally, with the captain's approval.	£60
Student	A full member but in full-time education and over 18.	£160
